HealthAlliance Hospital:

On October 30 HealthAlliance Hospital became a provisional **Level III Adult Trauma Center** expanding their Trauma Service for local residents in the region. With direct ties to WMCHealth HAHV now is part of one of the most comprehensive trauma networks in New York State. EMS agencies and residents of surrounding communities will now have access to expanded Trauma Services, expected to lessen patient transfers, expedite care during the crucial early moments after injury, and operate under the auspices of the Hudson Valley region's premier trauma service network. Through this designation, HealthAlliance Hospital will be able to fully leverage the academic, clinical, and telehealth capabilities of the Network to provide expert trauma care for all.
