What Can A Health Home Program Help YOU With:

- Connecting to medical, mental health and substance abuse services
- Making and remembering appointments, and help with transportation issues
- Help in understanding and finding affordable medications
- Keeping your treatment on track
- Stress management and crisis recovery
- Help with reapplying for Medicaid
- Help with finding affordable housing
- Assistance with applying for benefits
- Signing up for food assistance

To qualify for the Health Home Program, you:

- Have active Medicaid, **AND**
- have two or more chronic conditions (such as heart disease, Asthma, Diabetes, mental health condition, HIV/AIDS)
